COMMUNITY CENTER NEEDS ASSESSMENT TO BE CONDUCTED

Many individuals and groups in Kirksville have expressed interest in the development of a community center. Based on this, the City of Kirksville is partnering with the Center for Applied Statistical Evaluation (CASE) at Truman State University to develop and implement a needs assessment for Adair County that will determine the level of interest in a community center and what activities and amenities would be important in such a facility. If the survey results show enough interest, the City Council will begin to look for partnerships, grants and other resources that might assist in the planning and development of a new facility, or changes to existing facilities to meet the needs of our community.

CERT CLASS SCHEDULED FOR JANUARY

Do you want to be better prepared to help yourself, your family, your neighbors and your community after a disaster strikes? With debris-clogged or damaged roads, disrupted communications and the high volume of calls to emergency response personnel, you could be on your own for the first 72-96 hours after a disaster.

A new Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) class will be held in January at the Kirksville Fire Department. The 20-hour class will begin on Friday evening, January 20 from 6:00-9:30. The class will continue on the next two Saturdays, January 21 and 28, from 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. There is no charge for this CERT training.

CERT training is designed to provide citizens with the skills to perform essential life-saving functions while waiting for the professional responders to arrive following a disaster. Course topics include: disaster preparedness, disaster fire suppression, disaster medical operations, light search and rescue (including debris removal and victim extraction), disaster psychology, terrorism and team organization.
